Chairman Cllr Everett opened the meeting and welcomed those present and advised that an urgent item had arisen concerning the 3G facility managed by Drayton Youth Football Club and with the agreement of the meeting this item would be added to the agenda as item 9.5. All agreed.

3. The minutes having been previously circulated were signed as a true and accurate record by the Chairman after a small alteration to minute number 60 (8.2) where the word meetings was replaced with the word discussions.

4. Representations were received in respect of traffic calming on Hall Lane and Carter Road. It was noted that a paper copy of the Norwich Airport Masterplan had not been available in Drayton. It was felt that the proposed extension to night flight times should be opposed.

- Many complaints had been received concerning the proposed extension of night flight times to 1.30am within the Norwich Airport Masterplan. The BDC cabinet would meet on 15th August to discuss.

7.1 20171269 – 28 Winners Walk. First Floor Extension Over Existing Garage.

RESOLVED that there are no objections to the application, however it was disappointing to note the reduction of available car parking by converting the garage to living space.

9.2 Memorial Bench on School Road. **RESOLVED** to agreed that a memorial bench can be placed on the junction of School Road/ Bellomonte Crescent. Clerk to liaise with NCC Highways.

9.3 Street Names Plates. **RESOLVED** that the Parish Council would not like to see the new style street name plates in Drayton.

9.4 Norwich Airport Masterplan. **RESOLVED** that the Parish Council objects to any night flying by jet aircraft from Norwich International Airport between the hours of

23:00 and 0600 as determined by the inspector at the public enquiry when determining the operation of Norwich Airport. The result of the vote at this meeting should be made available to the local press.

9.5 Urgent Item. **RESOLVED** to :-

- Extend existing 3G facility agreement with Drayton Youth Football Club to 30 September 2017.
- Rent for period 1st September 2017 to 31st August 2018 to be £4000 a year plus VAT to be invoiced quarterly in arrears.

1. A response to the consultation on the Norwich Airport Masterplan will be considered by Broadland District Council Cabinet at its next meeting. I will of course attend this meeting and whilst supporting the plan in principle I have concerns regarding the proposed extension of flying hours which does not seem necessary. If London Heathrow can operate a night ban it is reasonable for the same restriction to apply to Norwich. The unpopular development charge of £10 per passenger needs to be reviewed as no improvements to infrastructure or passenger service have been forthcoming to date.
